

TOWN OF MARLBORO  
REGULAR SELECTBOARD MEETING  
Thursday, August 2, 2012

**ATTENDANCE:**

Present were select board members Craig Hammond, Chair; Andrea Livermore and Pieter van Loon. Also present was Adam Katrick, Animal Control Officer.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting came to order at 6:00 PM.

**APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF PAY ORDERS:**

The Board approved and signed pay orders.

**SCHEDULED AND UNSCHEDULED TIME:**

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

The Board approved the minutes of the 07/24/2012 regular meeting.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Pieter reported to the board that the issue regarding accumulating trash that appeared to be attracting rodents at a residence on Rte. 9 has been resolved. The homeowners hired Triple T Trucking to bring in a dumpster. A follow-up inspection of the premises was done and found that the barn was cleared of garbage.

Adam Katrick came in for his quarterly check in with the board. Issues discussed included his quarterly report (attached), recent incidents he has dealt with as ACO and concerns regarding equipment and training. Craig asked about ACO's authority to destroy animals. Adam is not sure what the protocol is, but will look into it. He will also determine whether or not the ACO can write tickets. Craig reported that he got a call from Lewis (Bo) Horvath about a dog that was apparently hit on Rte. 9 and ended up in his driveway. After a while the dog disappeared. Andrea got a call from Peggy Tiffany about a lost dog at her house. The owners were subsequently found and the dog returned. Both these incidents pointed to a need to get Adam's contact information out to the public. He will write something for the next Mixer. Adam also made up some business cards that he is handing out at every opportunity and will call the State Police and Windham County Sheriff to let them know to call him regarding animal control issues in Marlboro.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Francie Marbury has asked that the Board sign a letter of support for a grant from the VT Community Foundation for a new intergenerational poetry program that may involve community elders and students of Marlboro Elementary School.
