

TOWN OF MARLBORO  
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING  
Thursday, February 14, 2013

**ATTENDANCE:**

Present were select board members Craig Hammond, Chair, Andrea Livermore and Pieter van Loon. Also present was Select Board Assistant, Marcia Hamilton.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting came to order at 4:30 PM.

**APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF PAY ORDERS:**

The board approved and signed pay orders.

**SCHEDULED AND UNSCHEDULED TIME:**

No member of the public appeared during the unscheduled open public comment period.

**REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES/REPORTS:**

The board approved the minutes of the 01/24/2013 regular meeting and the 01/31/2013 special meeting. It also reviewed the draft of the select board article for the *Mixer*. Pieter wanted to expand the paragraph regarding the planning meeting among the board, the planning commission and Windham Regional Commission so he agreed to work on it and submit it to the *Mixer* editor by the deadline the next day. A discussion about the article on saving the post office concluded with the board agreeing the issue is not in its purview and Craig agreed to send an article to the *Mixer* editor on his own.

The board reviewed a personnel matter and voted (Hammond/van Loon) to go into Executive Session at 5:32 PM and voted (Livermore/van Loon) to come out at 5:54 PM.

The board discussed Pre-Town Meeting to be held Tuesday, February 26, 2013 at 6:00 PM directly after the select board meeting scheduled at 4:00 PM.

Craig reported on the Neighborhood Network meeting called together by Glenn Herrin, Emergency Management Director, which Craig attended a few days ago.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Pieter reported on the meeting he and Andrea attended with the Planning Commission and Windham Regional Commission (WRC). The meeting was an orientation of what WRC can do for Marlboro and what the Town has taken advantage of in the past.

The board signed the Annual Certificate of Highway Mileage on which was noted the changes to mileage on Adams Brook Road.

The board signed a liquor license renewal for Hogback Mountain Gift Shop.

The board members discussed having received comments that the roads had not been plowed early during snowfall of Winter Storm Nemo. People had trouble getting home. Pieter will talk with David Elliott and ask about his plowing policy.
