

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, April 25, 2013

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Pieter van Loon and Andy Reichsman. Andrea Livermore had a commitment elsewhere. Also present were Ed Lopata, Moss Hollow Road resident, and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:00 PM.

APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF PAY ORDERS:

The board approved and signed pay orders.

SCHEDULED AND UNSCHEDULED TIME:

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

There were no visitors to discuss the naming of the private road at Marlboro College. The board had no objections and voted (Reichsman/van Loon) to name the road Musicians Way, leaving it plural rather than possessive.

Ed Lopata came to the meeting to discuss road conditions in Marlboro. He wanted to know what measures the board is taking to improve safety on the roads. He was concerned about fire and rescue vehicles being able to navigate the roads in muddy conditions. He had concerns about his own travel on town roads when they are muddy. Board members agreed that they had their own issues with the roads. When asked, Ed stated he had not spoken with David Elliott recently. After discussion, the board decided to discuss these matters and others with David at the May 9 select board meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The board voted (Reichsman/van Loon) to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of 04/11/13.

OLD BUSINESS:

Pieter provided an update on his discussions about a sign ordinance. He spoke with Mary Sargent, Zoning Administrator. He said she, the Planning Commission and Development Review Board are in agreement that enacting a sign ordinance with enforcement features would be preferable to having sign regulations stated in another document.

Andy provided a status of the Muster Field Lease Agreement which was being reviewed by Geoff Dolman's lawyer. Andy stated that the instrument may become a service agreement rather than a lease agreement. Andy will report back to the board at another meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

After discussing Mike Andreotta's email indicating his interest, the board voted (Reichsman/van Loon) to appoint Mike Andreotta Energy Coordinator.

There was no additional new business to come before the board.

INFORMATION ITEMS AND MAIL:

Piet reported the junior high did a wonderful job of raking and cleaning up the recycling center recently. He sent them a note of thanks.
