

TOWN OF MARLBORO  
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING  
Thursday, November 21, 2013

**ATTENDANCE:**

Present were select board members Andrea Livermore, chair; Pieter van Loon and Andy Reichsman. Also present were Glenn Herrin, Emergency Management Director and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting came to order at 5:00 PM.

**APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF PAY ORDERS:**

The board approved and signed pay orders.

**SCHEDULED AND UNSCHEDULED TIME:**

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

Glenn Herrin reviewed emergency management updates including the Vermont Yankee (VY) shut-down schedule. He indicated the Radiological Emergency Response Plan will be updated for at least two more years. The board signed the current revision. He presented the FY14 emergency management budget update. Glenn reviewed the emergency management structure and key elements of the Town emergency management. He discussed transitioning out and stepping down once there is no need for radiological drills and response plans after VY shuts down. He will return in summer, 2014 with an update.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

The board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of 11/07/2013.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The board discussed the new Snelling Center Town website and the community meeting planned for Wednesday, December 11. Andrea will ask Forrest to attend the next select board meeting to discuss more about it.

The board voted (Livermore/van Loon) to approve the revised PACE documents and signed them.

The board appointed Carie Kowalski Green Up Coordinator for the one-year appointment from January 1 – December 31, 2014.

The board was to review the Stevens & Associates proposal to do the road inventory but the proposal never arrived as planned. Town Road and Bridge Standards are up to date.

The Windham Regional Commission Hearing on Marlboro's Town Plan is Scheduled for Tuesday, January 14 at 4:30 PM, just prior to the Planning Commission Meeting.

Andy reported that Peter Thurell of Soveren Energy will contact Marlboro College about partnering and participating in a shared solar array. He will get back to Andy and confirm.

The board voted (Livermore/van Loon) went into executive session to discuss a personnel matter at 6:44 PM. The board came out at 7:00 PM.

There was no new business to come before the board.
