### Proposed Mission

 The EM Committee advises the Emergency Management Director (EMD) and develops and maintains emergency operations plans in order to mitigate, prepare for, respond to, and recover from any emergency affecting the town.

- Manage Subcommittees

#### UNRESOLVED.

Outstanding issue: status of EM committee formed in 2007; EMD discussed with selectboard in November 2011 and, absent a defined charter or clear membership, SB and EMD agreed to proceed without a committee. However, at least two EOC members believed the 2007 committee was still viable.
