Marlboro's graduating High School seniors or college students who are continuing their undergraduate education in the 2014-15 academic year.

Eligibility: Graduating seniors must be Marlboro, VT residents during the 2013-14 school year. Student must be eligible for & seeking other financial assistance.

First-time applicants: send one copy of all of the following (paper) documents:

- 1. **A letter of recommendation** from teacher, principal, Guidance Counselor, community member or clergy (<u>not</u> relatives).
- 2. **Evidence that you have been accepted** to and plan to attend an accredited public or private vocational school or a 2- or 4-year accredited college.
- 3. **A brief letter** describing your proposed area of study, community service and summer employment or volunteer work.

Our decisions will be based primarily on community service and secondarily on academic achievement. Awards will be *at minimum* \$250 but may be more, and will be paid directly to the student.

Repeat applicants take note: If you have previously received an Alliance Scholarship, you may re-apply. Send (paper) documents that indicate you are enrolled and in good academic standing by the deadline below.

DEADLINE: All applications must be *postmarked or received* by Friday, May 23, 2014.

Late or Incomplete applications will not be considered.
