

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, June 12, 2014

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Andy Reichsman and Tyler Gibbons. Pieter van Loon was not present. Also present was Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:00 PM.

APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF PAY ORDERS:

The board approved and signed pay orders.

SCHEDULED AND UNSCHEDULED TIME:

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of 05/22/2014 and the Mixer article for the July/August issue.

OLD BUSINESS:

There have been no applicants for the position of Animal Control Officer. One person expressed interest but has not contacted the select board in writing. Mention is being made in the Mixer article about the request for interested applicants to contact the select board.

There has been no new information about the pending grant applications to Better Back Roads. The reporting for the first grant is due June 30 and Andy expects to have it from Stevens & Associates for select board review before the next meeting on June 26.

NEW BUSINESS:

The board signed the following documents:

- 2014 Dog Warrant
- 2014-2015 Windham County Sheriff's Department Contract
- 2014-2015 Windham County Humane Society Contract

The board authorized Town Clerk, Forrest Holzapfel, to be the Municipal Point Person for the Agency of Commerce and Community Development for informing towns as it develops the process to take applications for the Windham County Grant Program.

The board discussed the Notification of Pole and Wire Location received from Vermont Telephone Company, Inc. (VTel) for installation of a utility pole in the town road right of way. The pole would carry fiber, broadband facilities, and power, at the location described on the attached map and documentation. The pole appears to be near the intersection of Vermont Route

9 and South Road in the South Road right of way. The board will request more information from VTel and notify the landowner.

INFORMATION ITEMS AND MAIL:

The board received a notification from the Town of Guilford that the load capacity of the Green River Covered Bridge (Stage Road, Guilford, VT) has been reduced from 8 tons to 4 tons. Guilford asks the information be passed to anyone who would have a need to know. The letter will be forwarded to David Elliott, Road Foreman.
