REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, October 9, 2014

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Pieter van Loon, Chair; Andy Reichsman and Tyler Gibbons. Also present were David Elliott, Road Foreman; Nora Wilson, FEMA Claims Coordinator and Former Town Clerk; and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:04 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

Nora Wilson was present during the unscheduled open public comment period. She informed the select board that FEMA is unwilling to pay for the Collins Road bridge deck. There was discussion about the many hours spent after Tropical Storm Irene working with FEMA for reimbursement of all of the expense of the replacement deck of Bridge 26, FEMA's denials and Nora's appeals. The board agreed the Town will drop the claim and discontinue further pursuit of this claim.

The board approved and signed Pay Orders.

The board voted (Reichsman/Gibbons) to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of 09/25/2014 with changes to the draft as noted. The board voted (Gibbons/Reichsman) to approve the Mixer Report with the changes to the draft as noted.

David Elliott was present for the bid opening for the 2000 Freightliner FL80 sander/plow truck that has been sitting in front of the Town Highway Garage. There were two envelopes from the same person. One was the bid and one was a request to withdraw the bid. No action was taken and the truck is still for sale.

The board received a report of an abandoned car on Levi Howard Road in front of a residence. Piet will contact the owner of the property who may work with his tenants about removing the car.
