

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, December 18, 2014

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Pieter van Loon, Chair; Andy Reichsman and Tyler Gibbons. Also present was Jennifer Fitzgerald, Wilmington Town Nurse; Mary Sargent, Zoning Administrator; Linda Peters, Town Treasurer; Bill Esses, resident of North Pond Road; Ellen McCulloch-Lovell, Marlboro College President; and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:04 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

No changes were made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

Jennifer Fitzgerald was present during the Unscheduled Open Public Comment period. She is an elder advocate and is visiting area towns to gain support to help open a western office for Gathering Place for adult and senior day care in the former Wilmington High School building.

The board approved and signed Pay Orders.

The board voted (Reichsman/van Loon) to approve the minutes of the Regular meeting of 12/04/014 and voted (Gibbons/Reichsman) to approve the Mixer Report for the January-February issue. The board reviewed the Select Board Report for the Annual Town Report. The changes that were discussed will be incorporated into a second draft that will be visited again at the January 8 meeting.

Mary Sargent brought a proposal to the board for a zoning assistant that would redesign zoning forms, write a permit process and research area fee schedules for comparison to Marlboro's fee schedule. The board will consider the position as it works through the 2015 budget.

Linda Peters and the board discussed the actual 2014 and proposed 2015 budget. Further discussions will occur at the January 8 meeting.

Ellen McCulloch Lovell and the board discussed mutual college and town issues of interest. She said she would look for extra Windham County Sheriff Department patrols around January 18 when the students return for the second semester. The college is not having Internet problems as there are in other parts of town.

Bill Esses and the board discussed Internet solutions for low and no service in Marlboro. He and the board will develop a survey to collect information from town residents. The board will review it at the January 8 meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no old business to come before the board.

NEW BUSINESS:

The board voted (Reichsman/Gibbons) to appointed Carie Kowalski Green Up Coordinator to a term that runs January through December, 2015.
