ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Andy Reichsman, chair and Tyler Gibbons. Pieter van Loon joined the meeting at 5:50. Also present were Adam Gebb, Conservation Commission chair, and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:07 PM.
