REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING  
Thursday, April 23, 2015

**ATTENDANCE:**

Present were select board members Andy Reichsman, chair; Tyler Gibbons and Pieter van Loon. Also present was select board assistant, Marcia Hamilton.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting came to order at 5:04 PM.

**IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO THE AGENDA:**

Shelby Brimmer, possible Energy Coordinator candidate was not present but will be scheduled for the next meeting on May 14.

**SCHEDULED BUSINESS:**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The board continued discussion of considering designating some lands North of Route 9 at Hogback a Nature Sanctuary. Pieter suggests looking at the entire acreage to inventory all of the resources and see where it makes sense to preserve a section of forest that would not be logged and could continue to grow. No action was taken.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

There was no new business on the agenda.

**INFORMATION ITEMS AND MAIL:**

The board discussed the results of the Internet survey and prepared a brief report to residents that will be published on Front Porch Forum and the Town Website. It will also be posted at the Town Office.

The board reviewed a Petition of Duncan Cable TV to renew its Certificates of Public Good for its cable television system located in the town of Dover and apply for a Certificate of Public Good for the neighboring towns of Marlboro, Stratton and Wardsboro. DCTV is also seeking Public Service Board approval of its certificate of Public Good application for Marlboro, Stratton and Wardsboro, Vermont. No action was taken.

The board reviewed a letter and ring binder of information from Downs Rachlin Martin, attorneys for AT&T and the telecommunication tower proposed for Route 9, Snow Mountain regarding a Non-Substantial Change Determination, submitted in connection with a minor relocation of the utility lines serving the facility. No action was taken.
