

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, November 5, 2015

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Andy Reichsman, chair, Tyler Gibbons and Pieter van Loon. Also present were Merrill Mundell, Surveyor; David Elliott, Road Foreman; Bill Ledger, resident on Town Hill Road; and Marcia Hamilton, select board assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:01 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

No changes were made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

Merrill Mundell met with the board and David Elliott to review the preliminary survey plat and the accompanying letter explaining some unresolved issues. Mr. Mundell will generate right-of-way easement descriptions for the landowners for sections of the road through their land. He pointed out where he recommended locations for the permanent monumentation.

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

Bill Ledger discussed with the board his concerns about the speed of traffic on Town Hill Road. He cited several instances of hazardous driving. The board will contact the Sheriff's Department to request patrols on the road for a time as a deterrent. The board may also contact known commercial vehicles to request a reduction in speed.

The board approved and signed pay orders.

The board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of 10/22/2015.

OLD BUSINESS:

The board reviewed and signed the support letter for the Hogback Mountain Conservation Association grant application for Funds to Hire the Vermont Youth Conservation Corps to assist with the project to increase habitat Variety in the Hogback conservation Area

Pieter spoke with Mike Young, new ACO of Newfane, who seems interested in taking on animal control officer duties in Marlboro. A time will be set up for him to attend the November 19 select board meeting to meet with the board. Andy reported he spoke with Clarence Boston who has the ticket book used for enforcing the dog ordinance. The board discussed whether the ticket book would best be located in the Town Office. Andy will follow up with Clarence about it.
