

Marlboro Conservation Commission Minutes for Wed Dec 2, 2015

Those Attending: Adam Gebb ,Charlie Schneeweis and Dante Corsano

Visitors : Jim Herrick spoke about his knowledge of wildlife road crossings in town

We spent most of the meeting working out a process for documenting the Wildlife Road Crossings (WRC's_) very accurately on the landscape. We documented two crossings the following way...

1- We used the Motion X iphone app to GPS the exact location of each WRC. This satellite data posts to google maps with a KMZ file and includes a photograph.

2- We measured the length of the crossing with a rolling analogue counter.

3-We put white survey tape on both sides of the road at each end of the crossing.

I asked Jeff Nugent at the Windham Regional Commission to confirm that he can update the town WRC map with these new files and he says it will work.

Our plan is to repeat this process for all 22 WRC's in town.

The next CC meeting to continue the process will be on Thursday December 10th.
