REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING  
Thursday, June 23, 2016

**ATTENDANCE:**

Present were select board members Tyler Gibbons, Chair; Pieter van Loon, Vice Chair; and Patti Smith, member. Also present was Ron LaBrusciano, South Road resident and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting came to order at 5:00 PM

**IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:**

No changes were made to the agenda.

**SCHEDULED BUSINESS:**

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

The Pay Orders were approved and signed.

The board Approval of Minutes of the regular meetings of 06/09/2016

Prior to the meeting, Pieter van Loon contacted several residents along South Road and invited them to the meeting for a discussion on invasive plant control. Ron LaBrusciano, a resident in the Town Center, was the only one to attend. He stated he has a significant amount of Japanese knot weed on his property and he is very interested in getting rid of it. Because he has a well, he does not want to use any chemicals. No action was taken. Pieter will call around and see if more people can meet for another discussion.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Tyler Gibbons signed the South Road Paving Grant, PO1711.

There was no connectivity discussion update as warned on the agenda because all of the select board members attended the special select board meeting held just prior to this meeting.

Patti Smith, also a member of the Planning Commission (PC), updated the board on a proposed sign ordinance. She said it was discussed at the last PC meeting. A draft is being circulated among board members and they agree it still needs more work before it is presented to the select board for consideration.

Patti updated the select board on the schedule for the revised zoning regulations. She said a public hearing will be scheduled in August or September. An article about it will be out in the July/August Mixer.

Patti reported that a joint meeting of the Hogback Mountain Conservation Association and the Hogback Preservation Commission (HPC) met to discuss the biodiversity inventory that was in

the HPC budget for \$2,500 this fiscal year. The project may be larger than they first planned and they are considering applying for a grant.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Tyler signed the FY17 Windham County Humane Society Contract with a \$50 increase over the FY16 fiscal year contract from \$250 to \$300, the flat fee that the Town shall pay WCHS to serve as the impoundment facility for the Town to satisfy 20 VSA 3381.

**INFORMATION ITEMS AND MAIL:**

Marcia reported that Linda will try to have the short term disability information to the select board at the July 14 meeting.
