REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, November 3, 2016

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Tyler Gibbons, Chair; Pieter van Loon, Vice Chair and Patti Smith. Also present were Linda Peters, Delinquent Tax Collector; Adam Katrick, former Animal Control Officer; Ben Keating, animal owner on Lucier Road; and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:08 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

No changes were made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period.

The board approved and signed Pay Orders.

The board voted (Smith/Gibbons) to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of 10/27/2016.

Linda Peters brought a delinquent tax collection matter to the board and sought advice which was given.

Discussion occurred about a dog that has been a nuisance to neighbors. The purpose of the meeting was to provide suggestions for Ben Keating to control his dog. Adam Katrick described methods and options for controlling the dog such as building a confinement or an enclosure, training programs and using certain drugs under veterinary supervision. The board referred him to Bill Grant, a trainer in Putney. Ben Keating agreed to contact him.

The board voted (vanLoon/Smith) to appoint Malcolm Moore to an unexpired three-year term (2018) on the Hogback Preservation Commission filling the vacancy left by the resignation of Hal Himmelstein.
