In order to get Neighborhood Networks going, we need Area Organizers and Neighborhood Coordinators.


What do Area Organizers do?

- Request and report Neighborhood information for the Town during emergencies
- Attend annual committee meetings

What do Neighborhood Coordinators do?

- Organize communications trees within their Neighborhoods
- Distribute information from Area Organizers to residents as required
- Report Neighborhood information to Organizers during emergencies
