

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, August 13, 2015

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Andy Reichsman, chair, Tyler Gibbons and Pieter van Loon. Also present were Bob Gilbert, resident on Gilbert Road; Kevin F. F. Quigley, President of Marlboro College; Malcolm Moore, resident and surveyor; David Elliott, Road Foreman; and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:02 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

There were no changes made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

No member of the public was present during the open public comment period.

The board approved and signed Pay Orders.

The board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of 07/09/2015 (van Loon/Reichsman, Gibbons abstained), the regular meeting of 07/23/2015 (Gibbons, Reichsman, van Loon abstained) and the Mixer report for September/October (Gibbons/van Loon).

Kevin F. F. Quigley met the select board and they discussed Town and college matters such as the Town's contract with the Windham County Sheriff's Department. Mr. Quigley stated students arrive August 23-30. As issues and events of mutual interest arise, the parties will confer again.

Malcolm Moore, a resident surveyor, graciously offered to give the Town the road records that he has accumulated over the years. He has a card file index and a map on which he has hand written book and page of the land records. There was discussion about an index. He will look into creating an index that would include the land records and town records. When he has completed his review, he will come back to the select board for further discussion.

Malcolm declined the select board's request to survey Gilbert road but gave suggestions of names to the select board. The board will contact Merrill Mundell and request a proposal. There will be further discussion with Merrill Mundell at a board meeting regarding the elements of the proposal.

OLD BUSINESS:

Bob Gilbert, resident of Gilbert Road, was present during the discussion about Gilbert Road. He wants to see a speed limit of 10 mph. He is concerned about cars parked along the road.

NEW BUSINESS:

David Elliott reported that an offer of \$1,000 was made on the 1996 sander truck he has for sale in front of the Town Garage. It is a single axle component truck good for parts. The board authorized David to accept the offer. David also asked if the Better Back Roads grant will be awarded. Andy will check with David Antone

Pieter reported that he will follow up with two prospects about finding or sharing an Animal Control Officer.
