REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, July 27, 2017

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Pieter van Loon, Chair; Patti Smith, Vice Chair and Tyler Gibbons. Also present were David Elliott, Road Foreman; Linda Peters, Town Treasurer; Mike Andreotta, Emergency Management Director; and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

Pieter van Loon called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

No changes were made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled open public comment period or the scheduled public comment period on transferring the Hogback T-Bars from the Town to the Hogback Mountain Conservation Association. One favorable comment was received by email. It appears there is no controversy. No action was taken.

The board approved and signed Pay Orders.

The board voted (van Loon/Smith) to approve the minutes of the regular meeting 06/22/2017 and the special meeting of 07/17/2017.

David Elliott and the board discussed the Grant in Aid Award and said he met with Emily Davis of Windham Regional Commission. Most of the work would be along the roadways and no additional expenses would be incurred in the budget. David will work with WRC and provide an inventory. David then addressed the email forwarded by Forrest Holzapfel sent by a resident on Augur Hole Road. The resident requested road signs to slow traffic. David will take care of it.

The board, David and Linda Peters discussed the issues at the recycling center. Relations with Tam are excellent. Linda said she has been brainstorming with people to find solutions to reach people with information. She has received a lot of feedback from the public. Not everyone is on Facebook. The Mixer will be out in another month. Tyler will make a comment on Front Porch Forum, the two Facebook pages and prepare an article for the Mixer. Pieter will contact Greg Trucking and let him know he no longer needs to visit the recycling center to collect inappropriate recyclable items.

Mike Andreotta brought for signature the updated Local Emergency Operation Plan.

OLD BUSINESS:

Pieter will continue to attempt to contact the Animal Control Officer and the Lucier Road dog owner regarding unresolved issues.

NEW BUSINESS:

Pieter signed the FY 2018 Windham County Sheriff's Office contract on behalf of the board.

The board signed the Resolution for Zoning Permit Fee Waivers which exempts the Town and Marlboro School from paying permit fees and recording fees.

The Annual Traffic Tickets to Towns form from Judicial Bureau was completed by Marcia who will submit the form to the Office of the Court Administrator Judiciary Finance.

Patti will work with the concerned citizens on the South Pond Trail and deal with the beaver problem. This action originated by an email from Catharine Hamilton, President of the Ames Hill-Marlboro Community Center. The land with the beaver now belongs to AHMCC and the trail condition may be of concern.

Tyler updated the board about the upcoming Connectivity Committee meeting after this meeting.
