REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, August 10, 2017

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Pieter van Loon, Chair and Patti Smith, Vice Chair. Tyler Gibbons was away. Also present was Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 5:01 PM.

Pieter will contact Forrest Holzapfel to respond to his email about a person at the recycling center who may have been collecting returnable containers. The board agreed the road crew would not be contact people for the day to day operations of the recycling center. Pieter will get the word out through Forrest that the select board may be contacted by the Town Office or anyone with recycling questions or reports. The select board and not the Highway Department would be in on any decisions to contact the State Police in regard to the recycling center.

NEW BUSINESS:

Geoffrey Dohlman reported there was an unauthorized gathering at the Muster field that damaged a part of the hay crop. Patti will contact Forrest Holzapfel to see if anyone asked permission or applied using the use form to use the Muster field. Nobody should use the Muster Field before the hay is cut. If nobody at the Town Office gave permission, the people who used it will be contacted and told about the procedures to use the field.

The board received a letter from Rescue notifying the board of a meeting. The letter will be referred to Mike Andreotta, the Town's Rescue Representative. .
