

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, February 8, 2018

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Patti Smith, Vice Chair and Tyler Gibbons, Member. Pieter van Loon, Chair, was away. Also present were Woody Bernhard, resident; Peggy Tiffany and Patricia DeAngelo, Animal Control Officers; and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

Patti Smith called the meeting to order at 5:03 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

No changes were made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

Woody Bernhard came to the select board to inquire about hanging the CIVIL RIGHTS FOR ALL banner on or near the Town House. He spoke with Forrest Holzapfel during the day and was told he could hold the banner in a specially designated area in front of the Town Office used for citizens who want to make a public expression. Other locations for the banner were discussed. Tyler offered to look into the matter further and get back to Woody and the board when he has something to report.

When citizens need to call an ACO they will contact Peggy and she will coordinate with Pat when she is out of town. People will call Peggy's phone and receive instructions and contact information to reach Pat.

OLD BUSINESS:

Marcia reported she is in the process of contacting all towns in the former Vermont Yankee Emergency Planning Zone to see what their plans are for staffing and funding emergency management after the VY grants cease. She showed a spreadsheet and will continue to gather information to share with the board at an upcoming meeting.

There was no TAM Contract to sign and it is expected one will be available in the coming days.

Patti's update about the Green River Watershed Alliance was postponed to the next meeting.
