

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING
Thursday, February 22, 2018

ATTENDANCE:

Present were select board members Pieter van Loon, Chair and Patti Smith, Vice Chair. Tyler Gibbons was away. Also present were Mike Andreotta, Emergency Management Director and Marcia Hamilton, Select Board Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting came to order at 5:00 PM.

IDENTIFY ANY CHANGES TO AGENDA:

No changes were made to the agenda.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

No member of the public was present during the unscheduled public comment period.

The board approved and signed Pay Orders.

The board voted (van Loon/Smith) to approve the minutes of the Zoning Hearing of 02/19/2018 and the Special Select Board Meeting of 02/19/2018. The minutes of the Regular meeting of 02/08/2018 will be on the next agenda for information.

The board briefly discussed the email from the Agency of Natural Resources regarding Municipal Roads General Permit Issuance and agreed David Elliott will be the liaison and will comply with the requirements. In another matter, the board authorized David Elliott to install a SLOW Road Sign on Town Hill Road.

Mike Andreotta was present to discuss emergency management activities with the board. Mike has had conversations with Wayne Kermenski, Principal of Marlboro Elementary School, about emergency preparedness of the school. He also reviewed several other working relationships outside of Marlboro that he has made.

OLD BUSINESS:

Marcia reviewed a spreadsheet she created about emergency management budgets of towns in the Vermont Yankee Emergency Planning Zone and the other Windham County towns not in the EPZ. She was able to elicit responses from most of the towns about whether they have an emergency management director, how much time is spent in that function, whether the EMD functions in another town position, whether the town provides funds to staff the EMD or provide a stipend. The information will be used again next year during the budget review.

There was no TAM Waste Management contract to sign. Linda Peters and TAM are working up an agreement for this calendar year.

Patti updated the board about coming events sponsored by the Green River Watershed Alliance. There is a brochure available at www.greenriverwa.org. She highlighted the following events:

On March 24 there is a conservation easement workshop for landowners at Marlboro College 9AM-12:30PM. She is working with others to identify large landowners in town who would be interested in serving as ambassadors.

On April 29 there will be a Beavers, Floods, and Climate Change Workshop & Field Visit starting at Marlboro College and hosted by Patti Smith, 3PM-Dusk.

On May 30 Resilient Roads and Watersheds Forum in Guilford at 6PM will feature Road Foremen of Marlboro, Halifax and Guilford including David Elliott

NEW BUSINESS:

The board discussed a request by the Sugarloaf Mountain Athletic Club to hold a Marathon, with cooperation with Marlboro Section College to start at the College and run down Moss Hollow Road, on August 26, 7AM. The board approved the request and Marcia will reply to the email request that came through the select board email account.
