

MPA at South Pond 2019 Information

Clean-up day is Saturday, May 18th, 10am-noon (Rain Date; Sunday, May 19th)

Please note: Attending both the May and September clean-up days entitles you to a **Working Membership**. Donuts will be provided. Please bring your own beverages. If you want to bring something to share, please do.

Clean-up day tasks this year include:

- Cleaning up the parking lot
- Splitting and stacking wood from felled trees
- Putting out the docks
- Mowing grass
- Sweeping & cleaning the bathhouses, making repairs as needed
- Setting up swings and tetherball
- Raking beaches
- Organizing boats
- Cleaning up any shoreline debris
- Assembling picnic tables

Please bring boots and gloves. Especially needed are: mowers, battery operated drill and saws, rakes, shovels, wheelbarrows and trucks to haul wood and trash.

Membership Requirements

- All members must be year-round residents of Marlboro
- At least one person in the household must be a registered voter in the town of Marlboro

Family membership: More than one person in a household using the pond. This includes: adult(s) and child(ren) living together. This can include adult children living at home but does not include those who now live elsewhere. Adult children living elsewhere may be the guest of a member but must be accompanied by the member.

Individual membership: A single person using the pond. The individual must be a registered voter in the town of Marlboro.

Guest policy

- Members must accompany their guest while at the pond
- Guest passes are available to members for their guests
- All guest vehicles must display a pass, visible through the front windshield

Stickers can be purchased at clean-up day (Saturday, May 18th/Sunday May 19th), or by mail. Be sure to bring your checkbook to cleanup day! Only full price (non-working) memberships will be available after clean-up day. To pay by mail please send full payment to **Marlboro Park Association, PO Box 470, Marlboro, VT 05344. Please be sure to include your phone number and email address in your mailing.** Your payment must be received no later than **June 15th, 2019.** If you send a late payment, do not expect to immediately receive a sticker or a guest pass, as processing time is anywhere from 7-15 business days and based upon proper voting registration within the town of Marlboro.

For the upcoming 2019 season, the rates are as follows:

- \$120.00 for families
- \$60.00 for working families (adult children must live with you)
- \$60.00 for individual
- \$30.00 for working individual

Important note: Working members must attend both May and September clean-up

- Swim at your own risk

- Please do not remove any cleaning supplies from the bathroom
- Dogs are not permitted
- No Smoking on Beach
- Phone use on the field only, please turn off the ringer for the enjoyment of all
- **Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult**
- Members **must** accompany guests
- **No Kayaks, Canoes, or SUPs in swimming area-this is extremely important for the safety of all members**
- Fishing permitted from a boat only, not from the beach
- Use earphones for music
