Call to Order

Everyone introduced themselves. It was noted that the matter under consideration was 19-18 LD; that the applicants would speak under oath or affirmation; that a sound recording would be made in case of appeal; that this would be a quasi-judicial hearing with discussions and questions followed by a motion or executive session.

The Chair administered the oath. Julia Arduini and Anastasia Houze were duly sworn.

The applicants were recognized and explained that they had been before this Board two months ago to get a permit for a yurt on family property now owned by close relatives, on a 26 acre subdivision of the 128 acre lot located on Rt. 9 near the Golden Eagle motel.

It was noted that the subject of this meeting was the subdivision. There was discussion of requirement for frontage or a deeded right-of-way to public road or public water. The Chair invited questions from the Board. It was noted that the property is exempt from review of the Animal Conservation Overlay, as a "primitive camp"; and that a letter had been received from the property owners of 5295 Rt. 9, Maria Arduini, Linda Baker and Ralph Palladino, authorizing the applicants to represent the owners before this Board.

Ms. MacArthur moved that the issue be accepted for subdivision 19-18 LD. Second by Ms. Boardman. All in Favor.
