

TOWN OF MARLBORO
REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING

Thursday, July 25, 2019

5:00 PM

ATTENDANCE: Present were Select Board members Tyler Gibbons, Chair; Julia von Ranson, Member; Edie Mas, Planning Commission Member; and Lauren MacArthur, Select Board Assistant.

Jesse Kreitzer, Vice Chair was absent.

CALL TO ORDER: Tyler Gibbons, Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:02pm.

Scheduled Business:

Edie Mas, Planning Commission Member and head of the Wastewater Subcommittee came to ask if a Select Board member could attend a “kick-off” meeting with Dufresne Engineering regarding the wastewater planning investigation project. The meeting will take place on Monday, August 5, 5:30pm. Julia will attend and Edie will publicize it so interested town residents can also attend.

The Department of Health has offered to do some free well testing in September and October and the Planning Commission intends to invite everyone in the village district to participate in the testing, if they choose to. About ten people have already expressed interest.

APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE OF PAY ORDERS: The Pay Orders were approved and signed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The Select Board approved minutes from the regular meeting on 7/11/19. (Gibbons, von Ranson)

OLD BUSINESS:

The Select Board checked in about the Emergency Management Director position. An applicant has come forward and will be interviewed at the next Select Board meeting.

Details about implementing the tick testing subsidy will be determined at the next Select Board meeting because the program coordinator at UMASS is currently on vacation.

The Select Board adopted the new Road and Bridge Standards as updated by the VLCT to comply with the Municipal Roads General Permit. All sections were accepted except for the non-hydrologically-connected road segment section of the Class 4 Road Standards (section 2).

NEW BUSINESS:

The Select Board reviewed the minutes from the recent Marlboro Committee for Universal Broadband (MCUB) meeting on July 23, 2019. These minutes are also posted on the town website and bulletin boards.

INFORMATION ITEMS AND MAIL:

The Select Board acknowledged receipt by email of information regarding the current Marlboro College construction project and Act 250 permit information.

The Select Board received information about an event hosted by BDCC/SVEDS: Idea Jam on July 31, 2019.

The Town Clerk Incident Report was reviewed, including concerns about a squatter and possible environmental violations (at another site). Since the State Police are involved with the squatter issue, the Select Board will take no action at this time. Tyler will contact Forrest to speak about next steps in regard to pollutant clean-up on private property.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:45pm.
