Dear Mr. Kreitzer,

This is to advise you that on June 30, 2020, Marlboro College, located at 2582 South Road in Marlboro, VT, will be reducing its workforce and a total of 86 College employees will experience layoffs as a result of Marlboro's anticipated merger with Emerson College in Boston. Operations will end at the Marlboro College campus in Marlboro, VT, and while the faculty and academic program will be moving to Emerson beginning in August 2020, the Marlboro College campus will be closed.

Marlboro College expects layoffs to begin on June 30th, 2020. The layoffs may come in stages, depending upon the need for employees as the campus closure moves forward. However, we anticipate that a majority of staff will be laid off on June 30th. All layoffs will be permanent due to the closing of the worksite.

A list of the affected positions is enclosed. Affected employees do not have bumping rights and employees are not represented by a union.
