<b>Paper &amp; Cardboard</b>	<i>Materials Accepted:</i> <b>Cardboard:</b> shipping boxes, cereal boxes, egg cartons, paper towel/toilet paper rolls <b>Paper:</b> office paper, newspaper, paper bags, magazines, junk mail	<i>Cost:</i> <b>No charge</b>
	<i>Where it goes:</i> Goodenough takes the recycling to their facility in Brattleboro for processing. The material is marketed from there or goes to Casella's Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) in Rutland where it is sorted and baled then trucked to manufacturers who use them as a source material for new paper.	
<b>Bottles &amp; Cans</b>	<i>Materials Accepted:</i> <b>Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubs, &amp; Lids:</b> drink bottles, milk jugs, yogurt cups, etc. <b>Metal Cans:</b> soda and beer cans, soup and vegetable cans, foil (clean and balled up) <b>Glass Bottles &amp; Jars:</b> beer bottles, other beverage bottles, pickle jars	<i>Cost:</i> <b>No charge</b>
	<i>Where it goes:</i> Goodenough takes the recycling to their facility in Brattleboro for processing.
