Board for the Abatement of Taxes

Minutes – September 6, 2022

Meeting was called to order at the Marlboro Town Office at 4:21 PM by Chairman T. Hunter Wilson.

Present were: Select Board members Jim Agate (by phone) and Molly Welch; Justices of the Peace T. Hunter Wilson, David Holzapfel, and Marcia Hamilton; Treasurer/Justice of the Peace Linda Peters (by phone); and Town Clerk & Lister Forrest Holzapfel.

Forrest read the request from the Estate of Beverly Covey for an abatement of a portion of the taxes on the landed mobile home owned by Beverly Covey at 1061 Augur Hole Road, which was situated on the land of Violet Howard (tax map #06-02-12). The mobile home burned down on July 24, 2022 and Beverly Covey perished in the fire.

Forrest distributed a calculation sheet that Lister Chair Evan Wyse developed.

Discussion followed.

Moved by David Holzapfel and seconded by Marcia Hamilton to abate the 2022 taxes of Beverly Covey in the amount of \$86.35
