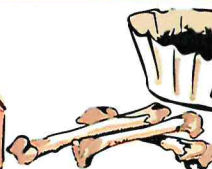
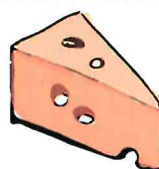
Food Scraps
