**Notes on Procedures:**

- All attendees will be asked to sign-in when they arrive to assist in the record keeping.
- **The proceedings will be recorded.**
- To facilitate the Hybrid nature of the meetings, the Board asks all participants to speak up when talking.
- To allow as many people to speak as possible, comments should be limited to 3-4 minutes. Should they have more to say, they can follow-up with additional comments after others have had a chance to have their say.
- Those residents who wish to comment or raise a question will be asked to raise their hand and wait to be recognized by the moderator. Again, all people speaking are urged to speak loudly and clearly and if they wish approach the main table to be closer to the “Owl Microphone” so that they can be heard on the ZOOM side of the meeting.
- For those attending via ZOOM, please use the “Raise Hand” icon so that Nick, who will be monitoring the ZOOM, can get your name to the moderator, please wait till recognized to “unmute” and have your say. For ZOOM, please feel free to use the “comments” option to pose questions which Nick will then report to the Moderator at the appropriate time.
- Once a comment and associated discussion is completed, the Moderator will call on the next resident for comment or move onto the next Article.
- While the meeting has a scheduled end time (see above), the Board will do everything in its power to make sure all questions have been addressed (or table to be discussed at a regular Select Board meeting) prior to the adjournment of the meeting.
- As there is a limited amount of time at this meeting, the Moderator will attempt to limit discussion and comment to any single article to roughly 15 minutes. Should more time seem to be necessary, the topic will be revisited once all other items or questions have been reviewed.
- **FINALLY, THE SELECT BOARD WOULD LIKE TO REMIND ALL RESIDENTS THAT WHILE THESE INFO MEETINGS ARE SPECIFICALLY FOCUSED ON THE 2025 TOWN MEETING WARNING/BALLOT, THERE IS ALWAYS THE OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST TIME (SCHEDULED OR OPEN PUBLIC COMMENT) AT ANY REGULAR SELECT BOARD MEETING TO PROPOSE AND DISCUSS OTHER POTENTIAL TOWN ISSUES OR CONCERNS.**
