- Current Use: How do we inform people of their options re: the choice between participating in a forestry/logging plan and saving tax money. Are there other ways to save money that does not include logging heavily, since taxes continue to go up? Raf Rosner recommended *forestcarbonworks.com*
 - Town Info Meeting regarding this topic? OR seek out individuals in town who are eligible for current use tax exemption and have a "cup of tea" conversation to discuss non-logging options.
