

Motor oil (clean oil-.....\$1.00 per gallon can be used or unused but must be clean- no contaminants as we burn this in our waste oil furnace. Motor oil (dirty oil)-....\$10.00 per gallon

This must be disposed of as hazardous waste, and

only collected on Tuesdays @ HHW Depot (May-Oct), or at the scale (Nov-April)
