## ACCESS PERMITS (windshield stickers)

Valid for a year, July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.  
The next year's permits go on sale May 1<sup>st</sup> each year.

<b>Annual Permit</b> .....	\$60
<b>½ year permit</b> (Available after Jan. 1) .....	\$35
<b>Single-Day Pass</b> .....	\$15

## SERVICES with an ACCESS PERMIT

### Household Trash

33-gallon bag or smaller .....	\$5 per bag
Contractor bag .....	\$10 per bag
32-gallon barrel .....	\$15 ea.
All other trash .....	\$30 for up to 275 lbs.
Over 275 lbs. (by weight on the scale) .....	\$215 per ton

### Construction Debris

Minimum disposal fee .....	\$30 for up to 275 lbs.
Over 275 lbs. (by weight on the scale) .....	\$215 per ton

### Household Items

Vacuum .....	\$5
Gas Grill .....	\$5
Mattress/Box Spring (All sizes) .....	\$50 ea.
Chair/Recliner/Loveseat .....	\$15
Sofa, and/or sectional .....	\$25
Sleeper Sofa .....	\$30

### Tires

Bicycle .....	\$3
Passenger vehicle (includes motorcycles, pickups) .....	\$5
Passenger vehicle on the rim .....	\$8
Truck/Tractor/Loader or Bulk Loads . (call for pricing)	

**With an access permit, these items have NO CHARGE:**

### Food Scraps

Food scraps and soiled paper, see backside

### Recycling

Paper and Bottles & Cans, see backside

### Leaves & Grass Clippings

No brush, logs or branches (More than 5 bags of grass)

**House Paint** Oil, Stains, Latex, Polyurethane ..... Free

### Electronics

Computers, TVs, Printers, Peripherals .....	Free
Businesses >10 employees bringing 7+ units are subject to fees	
Other electronics .....	\$5 ea.
Floor-model copiers.....(large electronics) .....	\$35 ea.
Wires & cables .....	Free

### Batteries

Alkaline (regular AA, AAA, C, D, button) .....	Free
Rechargeable (Lithium, NiCad) .....	Free
Small Lead-Acid (lawnmower, motorcycle) .....	\$4
Large Lead-Acid (Car/Truck/Marine) .....	\$6

### Fluorescent Lightbulbs

CFLs (spiral lightbulbs) .....	Free
Straight Tubes .....	\$.35/foot
PCB ballasts .....	\$6/ each
Ballasts (non-PCB) .....	\$3/ each

**Clothing, Shoes, Sheets, Accessories** ..... Free

**Books** (Hardcover, paperbacks, cookbooks) ..... Free

**Scrap Metal** (by the load, sm-med-lg) ..... \$5-\$10-\$20

### Appliances

With Freon (A/C, dehumidifiers, freezers, fridges) .....	\$25
Without Freon (microwaves, dishwashers, etc.) .....	\$15
Commercial Equipment .....	\$50

### Propane and other Tanks

Camp Tank (1 lb.) .....	\$2.50
Grill Tank (20 lb.) .....	\$10
Insulation Tank (spray foam) .....	\$25
Fire Extinguisher .....	\$5

**Brush/Logs/Stumps/Grass** ... \$10 min, or \$100 per ton  
(by weight on the scale)

**Oil filters** (small/large) ..... \$ .50/\$1.00 ea.

## MOTOR OIL IS ONLY COLLECTED ON TUESDAYS

**Motor oil (clean oil)** ..... \$1.00 per gallon  
can be used or unused but must be clean- no  
contaminants as we burn this in our waste oil furnace.

**Motor oil (dirty oil)** ..... \$10.00 per gallon

This must be disposed of as hazardous waste, and  
only collected on Tuesdays @ HHW Depot (May-Oct),  
or at the scale (Nov-April)

- Pet waste (cat & dog)- if bagged, only in paper or BPI-Certified bags
- **BPI-Certified Products:**
  - Compostable Bags
  - Cutlery
  - Paper Plates/Paper Cups
  - Take-out Containers

- NO Livestock Manure
- NO Ice Cream Containers
- NO Frozen Food Boxes
